

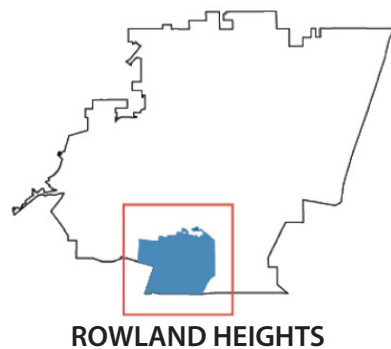
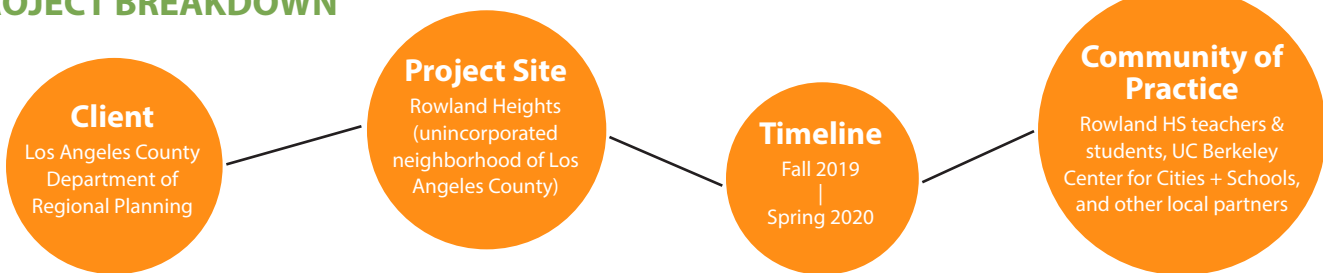
## ABSTRACT
