

Y-PLAN Site Visit | Escuela Popular Affordable Housing in San José



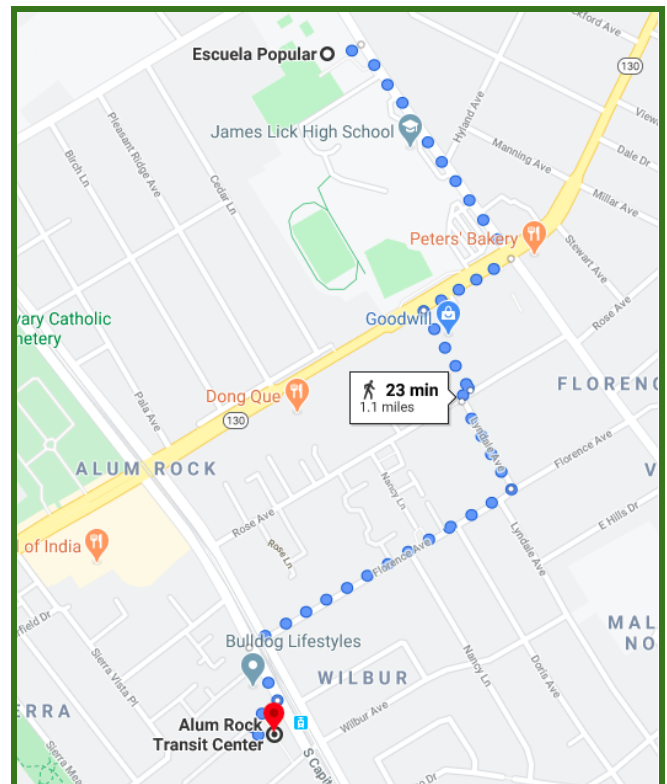

STOP 1: Neighborhood Walk + Alum Rock Transit Center

We will be starting with a walk to Alum Rock Transit Center. While we are walking, pay attention to the neighborhood around you. Consider these questions and write down your thoughts:

- **What made you feel safe + comfortable, or unsafe + uncomfortable?** / ¿Que te hizo sentir cómodo y seguro, o incomodo e inseguro?
 - **What is still needed to make it safer?** / ¿Qué se necesita todavía para hacerlo más seguro?
 - **If you lived here, what would you need to feel safe and happy?** / Si vivieras aquí, ¿qué necesitarías para sentirte seguro y feliz?

- **What kind of housing is available (single family or multi-family?)** / ¿Que tipo de viviendas están disponibles (casas o apartamentos)?



- **What is the condition of the houses/apartment complexes? Are they old or new? / ¿En qué condición están las viviendas?**

- **How could we produce more affordable housing? / ¿Cómo producimos más viviendas?**

- **What amenities /services are being provided in the neighborhood? / ¿Cuales servicios hay para la comunidad**

- **We will be taking public transportation from Alum Rock to SJSU. While on the bus think the following / Cuando estemos en el autobús piensen en lo siguiente:**
 - **How is the city changing? / ¿Cómo está cambiado la ciudad?**
 - **What kind of housing do you see throughout the city? / ¿Que tipo de viviendas miras en la ciudad**

STOP 2: San José State University



This is where we're having lunch. We will have time to explore the university and learn from college students about the challenges of living near the campus. We will also explore the housing that is available around the campus.

SPEAKER: Diana, President of Student Homelessness Alliance, will be speaking to us about students who experience homelessness in college. STOP 3: Affordable Housing Options

Map Labels:

- **Yellow Dots:** senior housing / para las personas mayores
- **Purple Dots:** special needs housing / para necesidades especiales
- **Blue Dots:** family housing / para familias
